

What is the Pathways Program?

The **Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission**, in partnership with East End Community Services, the National Association of Regional Councils and the U.S. Department of Labor, are offering multi-faceted career path strategies, training, and job placement in green jobs.

The Program offers opportunities for:

- Trainings, certifications, and credentials in a green industry
- Interviewing opportunities for jobs in a green industry
- Case management and supportive services

This program is free of charge but eligible candidates must fulfill the eligibility requirements and must be willing to fulfill all training requirements which include pre-employment services, classroom, and on-the-job training (see basic program process in diagram below). Upon successful completion of program requirements, participants will be assisted with opportunities to interview for employment placement.

Please note that all potential participants must provide necessary documentation as well as submit to a background check and drug screening.
