The Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission, in partnership with East End Community Services and its local partners (Dayton Urban League, Sinclair Community College, Kettering City Schools), the National Association of Regional Councils and the U.S. Department of Labor, are offering multi-faceted career path strategies, training and job placement in green jobs. The Program offers opportunities for:

- Trainings, certifications and credentials in a green industry
- Interviewing opportunities for jobs in a green industry
- Case management and supportive services

This program is free of charge but candidates must fulfill the eligibility requirements and must be willing to fulfill all training requirements which include pre-employment services, classroom and on-the-job training. Upon successful completion of program requirements, participants will be assisted with opportunities to interview for employment placement. Please note that all potential participants must provide necessary documentation as well as submit to a background check and drug screening.

We are accepting online applications as of today, Tuesday September 28th, 2010. Clients are required to complete an online application in order to be considered for the program. We are expecting a large volume of completed applications and will process them on a first come first serve basis. Applicants will receive notification from a member of the Pathways team.

The *Pathways Out of Poverty* grant provides for approximately 220 disadvantaged and dislocated workers to receive green jobs training in the fields of deconstruction, building performance, HVAC or green landscaping.
